

Scout Amik – Recommended Packing List

Winter camping in Manitoba requires that special care and attention is paid to clothing.

Below is the **recommended** clothing list. Group Scouters/Leaders are responsible for the safety and comfort of your youth this weekend and to make sure they have all items needed for camp.

Note: Anyone that is not appropriately dressed for weather may not be able to participate in certain activities.

Recommended Clothing & Equipment List:

- Full Uniform
- 3-4 pairs heavy socks
- 2 pairs thermal long johns
- 2 pairs of warm pants
- 2 extra pairs of underpants
- 2 extra pairs of light socks
- 2 thermal T-shirts
- 2 long-sleeved shirts
- 1 pair of snow pants and parka
- 1 toque (2 if possible)
- 1 pair of winter boots (2 if possible)
- 2 pairs of warm mitts
- 1 scarf (2 if possible)
- 2 pairs of pajamas
- 1 pair of indoor shoes
- Extra pair of sweats – backup spare.

Other Items:

- Sleeping Bag
- Pillow
- Extra blanket (optional)
- Flashlight
- Wash-up Kit—Toothbrush and paste, Face cloth and towel, Soap, Comb, Kleenex)
- Towel for washing/shower
- **Required for activity - Extra Light-Colored T-shirt for Silk Screening**

****Note: Please label all clothing and equipment to ensure lost items are returned.**

ALL MEALS AND SNACKS ARE PROVIDED BY THE CAMP.

- Specialty food for dietary restrictions can be kitchen staff for storage.
- Do not bring any extra food to camp. Food is not allowed in the cabins and there may be campers that have allergic reactions to items bought.
- Youth medications are to be managed by the group Scouters/leaders.

Note: Electronics (except cameras) are not recommended to be brought to camp and may be confiscated if found being misused until the end of camp. Leaders – please set your phones to vibrate only.
