

Emergency/Action Plan – Operation IceCap

Camp Arnes

1. All groups are required to carry with them at all times, copies of medical and emergency contact information for all their group attendees. All OOS are required to provide Camp Administration (non-registered or SC members) a paper copy of their physical fitness medical and emergency contact form.
2. Emergency phone numbers:
 - a. Hospital (Gimli): 204 642-5116
 - b. Police (Gimli RCMP): 204 642-5104 or 911
 - c. Fire: 911
3. Gimli hospital-19km south of Camp Arnes on PTH 222, or by Highway 8
4. Certified First Aider(s) with aid kit is on site 24hrs
5. Camp provides phone number for communication between campers and first aider
6. Evacuation plan-assemble in dining hall, proceed to parking lot, enter vehicles and convoy out.
7. All accidents or incidents are immediately uploaded with the “ScoutSafe” mobile app, and/or paper forms are filled out and submitted to Scouts Canada.
8. Groups attending are provided Camp Admin & First Aid contacts to call if required during the camp.
9. Emergency repair kits are not needed as Camp Arnes has their own maintenance personnel on site Camp Arnes staff available 24 hrs.
